## **URGENT ALERT:**

### **TO OUR VALUED WEARING APPAREL AND TEXTILE CLIENTS**

As you may be aware Textile Declarations were eliminated for all countries effective October 5, 2005.

However, Customs is now requiring the origin-conferring manufacturer be used for the Manufacturer ID (MID). *This is the actual manufacturer of the product(s), **not** the invoicing party, exporter, holding company, etc.*

We at Alba Wheels Up International Inc. will construct and transmit the MID. In order to do so properly, we need to know the complete name and address of the actual manufacturer who made the product(s).

When a single entry is filed for products of more than one manufacturer, the products of each manufacturer must be separately identified.

In order to avoid any delay in processing your documentation, please be sure your commercial invoice clearly indicates the complete name and address for the actual manufacturer of the product(s).
